

**Prayer dictated by Jesus to Saint Matilda (Maud)
to help the souls of the dead in Purgatory**

Recite with devotion and love the following prayer for nine consecutive days



First day

“Our Father who art in heaven

Please, O heavenly Father, forgive souls in Purgatory, for they did not like you or made all the honor that is due to you, their Lord and Father, who by grace, have adopted them as your children; but instead, they have you in their sins, driven from their heart yet still where you want to live.

In reparation for these faults, I offer you love and reverence your incarnate Son you testified throughout his earthly life, and I offer all shares of penance and satisfaction which He performed and by which He cleared and atoned for the sins of men. So be it.

Second day

Let your name be hallowed

I beseech you, Father Most Good, pardon the souls in Purgatory, for they do not always have worthily honored your holy name, but they have often uttered in vain and they went unworthy of the Christian name with their lives sins.

In reparation for these sins they have committed, I offer all the honor that your beloved Son made on your behalf by his words and by his actions throughout his earthly life. So be it.

Third day

Thy will be done on earth as in heaven

Please, Father Most Good, pardon the souls in Purgatory, for they have not always submitted their will to yours, they did not try to do your will in all things, even they have often experienced and acted only by their will.

In reparation for their disobedience, I offer you the perfect conformity of heart full of love of your Divine Son with Your Holy Will and the most profound submission qu'll you testified you obeying until his death on croix. Ainsi Amen.

Fourth day

Give us today our daily bread

Please, Father Most Good, pardon the souls in Purgatory, for they have not always received the Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist with enough desire, but they have often been without contemplation, or love, or even unworthily, or they have even failed to receive it.

In reparation for all these sins they have committed, I offer the eminent holiness and great recollection of our Lord Jesus Christ, your divine Son, and the ardent love with which He made us this incomparable gift . So be it.

Fifth Day

Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us

Please, Father Most Good, pardon the souls in purgatory all the mistakes they have made guilty by succumbing to the seven deadly sins, and also did not want or love or forgive their enemies.

In reparation for all these sins, I offer prayers loving your Divine Son sent to you on behalf of his enemies when he was on the cross. So be it.

Sixth Day

And lead us not into temptation

Please, Father Most Good, pardon the souls in Purgatory, because too often they did not resist the temptations and passions, but they followed the enemy of all good and were abandoned to the lusts of the flesh .

In reparation for all these sins multiple forms, which they have been guilty, I offer you the glorious victory that our Lord Jesus Christ has won over the world and his holy life, work and sorrows, suffering and its very cruel death. So be it.

Seventh Day (end of the novena dictated by party games)

But deliver us from evil

and all punishment under the merits of your beloved Son and lead us and the souls in Purgatory, in your kingdom of eternal glory that identifies you. So be it. "

Eighth day (personal prayer to St. Maud)

At Sainte Maud image that showed great charity towards his people and his relatives by distributing all of its well royals, let's turn to our charitable towards others and detach us as well Sainte Maud land to prepare our souls for the Kingdom of God. Oh Holy Maud, intercede for us with God to get away from the temptations and desires of this world to preserve our love relationship with Jesus.

Ninth day (personal prayer to St. Maud)

Sainte Maud, my great beloved sister, you who overcame all difficulties especially those of your loved ones, helps us to keep hope in Jesus in our difficulties of this life and fills us with special graces to keep us in joy and in faith. You who one day your son reminded not to focus on the vanities of this world, saying "My son, she said, watching Otto senior, if you stand on your father's throne, remember that you go down one day in his grave. "Teaches us to detach ourselves from the things of this world and seek first the Kingdom of God, where is our true eternal goods in the love of God our Father. Amen
